We will also be doing lots of work on identifying amounts quickly, for example recognising dots on a dice.</p>	<p>Personal Social and Emotional Development</p> <p>Our PSHE sessions will focus on celebrating difference.</p> <p>We will continue to identify children who are being a Determined Derby but will also be introducing the children to our other learning heroes too.</p>	<p>Physical development</p> <p>We will continue to develop our fine and gross motor skills through daily dough disco and pencil grip activities.</p> <p>We are excited to welcome sports coaches into school on Monday afternoons too.</p>
<p>Understanding the World</p> <p>We will be thinking about our past birthdays and talking about how we celebrated them. We will also be commenting on and asking questions about the world around them.</p>	<p>Expressive arts and design</p> <p>Using different materials, the children will be making firework pictures and make models by joining materials together.</p>	<p>Communication and language</p> <p>Throughout this half term the adults will encourage the children to speak clearly to each other, listen to each other's ideas and encourage turn taking.</p>
